PUBLIC NOTICE CITY OF WEST LIBERTY

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

The City of West Liberty Service Department began its fall leaf pickup the week of October 16, 2017. Leaves should be placed at the curb, <u>not</u> in the street, for leaf machine pickup. <u>Do Not</u> mix yard waste with the leaves. Yard waste material plugs the tube to the leaf machine causing equipment breakdowns. Grass clippings may be put with the leaves. No scheduled days will be set – pickup will be done on a random basis as the weather permits and there are no equipment breakdowns. Leaf pickup will end November 30th.

BRUSH AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION:

The last brush and yard waste pickup for the year will be *Wednesday, November 16th*. Brush should be cut to four (4) foot lengths and placed parallel to the curb. Yard waste <u>must</u> be separated from the leaf and brush piles and continued to be placed in containers or bags for collection. Brown Kraft yard waste bags purchased at City Hall or Menards, Lowes, WalMart or Blains Farm & Fleet may be used for leaf/yard waste collection.

BURNING YARD WASTE & LEAVES

As a reminder open burning is only allowed during the last two weeks in October (14 days) and only leaves, clean brush, and garden residue may be burned during the open burning period. Burning may only be performed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m or sunset, whichever is earlier.
