

**PUBLIC NOTICE

REMINDER
Burning Regulations

The City of West Liberty allows for open burning from **April 1st through April 14th** and would like to remind all residents of what the burning regulations allow:

- a. Open burning may only be performed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. or sunset, whichever is earlier.
- b. Open burning shall be at least 20 feet away from any structure, excepting barbeque grills and other outdoor cooking appliances which may be used within 20 feet of a structure. Open burning shall be at least 5 feet away from the closest lot line of any property adjoining the property on which the item(s) is being burned.
- c. Open burning of the following materials is expressly prohibited at all times: Construction materials, garbage, furniture, tires, plastic, or any other recyclable materials or other refuse.
- d. Only leaves, clean brush, and garden residue may be burned during the open burning

OPEN BURNING, STREETS, CURBS, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any materials on any streets, gutters, curbs, sidewalks, alleys, or other publicly owned property or right of way within the City of West Liberty.
