

**PUBLIC NOTICE
CITY OF WEST LIBERTY
2019 FALL LEAF
COLLECTION AND BURNING**

The City of West Liberty Service Department began its fall leaf pickup the week of **October 14, 2019**. Leaves should be placed at the curb, ***not*** in the street, for leaf machine pickup. ***Do Not*** mix yard waste with the leaves. Yard waste material plugs the tube to the leaf machine causing equipment breakdowns. Grass clippings may be put with the leaves. No scheduled days will be set – pickup will be done on a random basis as the weather permits and there are no equipment breakdowns. Leaf pickup will end November 27, 2019.

BRUSH AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION:

The last brush and yard waste pickup for the year will be *Wednesday, November 15th*. Brush should be cut to four (4) foot lengths and placed parallel to the curb. Yard waste ***must*** be separated from the leaf and brush piles and continued to be placed in containers or bags for collection. Brown Kraft yard waste bags purchased at City Hall or Menards, Lowes, WalMart or Blains Farm & Fleet may be used for leaf/yard waste collection.

BURNING YARD WASTE & LEAVES

Allowed OPEN BURNING schedule for October 2019
October 18, 2019 through October 31, 2019 (14 days)

BURNING REGULATIONS

- a. Open burning may only be performed between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. or sunset, whichever is earlier.
- b. Open burning shall be at least 20 feet away from any structure, excepting barbeque grills and other outdoor cooking appliances which may be used within 20 feet of a structure. Open burning shall be at least 5 feet away from the closest lot line of any property adjoining the property on which the item(s) is being burned.
- c. Open burning of the following materials is always expressly prohibited: Construction materials, garbage, furniture, tires, plastic, or any other recyclable materials or other refuse.
- d. Only leaves, clean brush, and garden residue may be burned during the open burning

OPEN BURNING, STREETS, CURBS, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS. It shall be unlawful for any person to burn any materials on any streets, gutters, curbs, sidewalks, alleys, or other publicly owned property or right of way within the City of West Liberty.
