Muscatine County Comprehensive Plan Visioning Workshop

Muscatine County, IA – Muscatine County officials are seeking citizens' input for the development of a comprehensive land use plan update for the county. The plan provides the foundation for future growth and development in Muscatine County for the next 15-20 years.

Residents of Muscatine County can participate in this workshop, which will both include visioning and mapping exercises:

No registration is required. During the two-hour workshop, citizens and interested stakeholders will learn about the comprehensive planning process and participate in an interactive session to give input on how land may be developed in the future. The public's input will help review and update a county vision and clarify goals as part of the comprehensive plan.

A Steering Committee of volunteers is guiding the plan development and will make recommendations to the County Board for the update. Staff from Bi-State Regional Commission will facilitate the meeting, which is open to the public.
